Executive Summary

Our Mission: Luke's Wings is a 501c3 nonprofit organization. Recognizing the immediate need for families to be with their loved ones at such a difficult time, Luke's Wings provides families with the means to visit service members during their hospitalization and rehabilitation.

Performance Summary: Luke's Wings was incorporated in January, 2008. Between January 2008 and December 2010, Luke's Wings raised \$211,679 from donations, sponsorships, and (fundraising) ticket sales. With that revenue, Luke's Wings booked 240 airplane tickets to bring loved ones to the bedsides of our wounded warriors currently recovering all over the country. 2011 proved to be a banner year, raising \$960,976 and spending more than \$123,000 on flights for our wounded warrior families. Planning for the future: In 2012, Luke's Wings strives to solidify and grow our team to help ensure current and future sustainability, update our website to be more sophisticated, increase our ability to collect and track donations, develop stronger relationships with the White House, partners and corporate sponsors, and gain acceptance with the Better Business Bureau, Guide Star, and the Combined Federal Campaign.

Results: Our ROI can be summed up with this one simple letter from a wounded warrior wife:

"I cannot Thank LUKE'S WINGS enough for the love and compassion you showed my family!!! It was always amazing to see our boys and thanks to you all we were able to see them ALOT!!!!!!!
